Community agencies, non-profits, faith-based and civic organizations, colleges and universities and individuals work with schools and the school division to create extraordinary opportunities that build skills, resilience, and positive assets in male youth. #### **WAYS TO CONNECT WITH RISE**

There are many ways that individuals and organizations can support RISE Male Empowerment programming. Here are just a few:

- Small group mentor
- One-to-one mentor
- Guest speaker
- Lead or support a mentoring club
- "Adopt A School" (An organization adopts a specific school).
- School-based community partner (visit cafeterias, be a presence at schools at events, during class changes, arrival and dismissal, etc.)

- Sponsor or chaperone a field trip
- Read to students
- Coordinate a service project
- Conduct a workplace readiness activity (ex. job shadow, mock interviews, resume building, etc.)
- Leadership training
- Special event organizer (ex. recreation, social, career exploration, etc.)
